6. Socio-economic Profile:

SCS is helping **KS** work on the Profile. They will meet with Hannah Reynolds (contracted until 31 August 2007) on the 16th July, who will present evidence to use in the final town plan. Cost of this work is £3000 which is to be paid from our original £5000.

MP - Podium Events. It is suggested that we make sure we have adequate policing, first aid, insurance, licensing etc when using the podium or central car park especially for any event that involves bands. We need to keep Highworth Town Council involved and informed at all times.

TA - facilities need to be made for a higher amount in the petty cash, suggestion £80. All petty cash items to be backed up with original receipts and amounts signed for. **KS** to do letter to David Lane, HTC to allow **TA** to increase when needed. Proposed by **PNS** seconded by **SCS**.

KS – Wednesday 11th July, he will attend the Stronger Communities Forum about Highworth's aspirations and barriers we may face achieving them.

Mike Wilson - Highworth Passion, **KS** will be helping.

Mike Wilson along with HCPG would like to do something for New Year celebrations **PNS -** has looked into hiring a portable ice skating rink for the central car park.

Highworth 2008 Festival – they need new committee members and volunteers.

PH - would like to get meetings going with local businesses. Looking into Wine and Cheese evening on Thursday 30th August where we can meet the businesses, **PH** to chair.

Police issue – HTC not happy with non attendance of police to incidents. Letters have been written, meetings in hand.

PNS – Met with pupils of Warneford School to help them with the school magazine. A print of 3000 copies, these go to every pupil, also this time going to some businesses and Doctors surgery. HCPG could do write up to be included. Contact being made with the school.

We should look for a new Vice Chair which doesn't have to be a councilor, but this is being looked into.
