### 4. Vice Chairs Report:

- a) Council Update:
- Melanie Duff new Mayor of HTC. She will be directing HTC and SBC to working with us.

## 6. Fox Roundabout:

- a) SBC Restrictions: We can go ahead in accordance with legal requirements.
- b) Design: SBC landscaper Andrew Norris attended site said it was a bleak roundabout. He has drawn up some plans which we can put before SBC. He suggests no plants as they don't survive very well, use local stone with up lighting to enhance sculpture. Must keep arrow and chevron signs.
- c) Additional Sponsorship: Hopefully start this summer. There are many places where small funding is available. Also local people to give time and we will fund materials.

# 7. Gilberts Alley: JC

Looked at 1910 land survey in Chippenham, information between 1910-1980 not found as land registration in Wiltshire came in 1980. Do we need to fill in this gap? Decided as soon as building work finished, post notices along alley, in Advertiser, Link and Swindon Web for landlords to come forward, if no response or objections after reasonable time we will gentrify anyway. SBC not bothered about planning permission as private land. Do proposal after this. Ken S and SR will write notice for next meeting.
