Allyson Jordan - Following closure of some libraries a full consultation with users and non users of libraries has taken place towards a new whole library strategy. Allyson asked HCPG if we could help with ideas to promote and improve the library services remembering different aspects for different towns needed. Interim findings are as follows: Hardest area to ask was non-user males between 35-59 and those too busy. How could we promote this age range? (Football clubs, pubs) Conversation followed with ideas. Make use of Friends of Library, HCPG could assist them in finding funding to help run courses. Set up a Marketing and Advertising Group to better promote.

Michelle Matthews – Is one of four engagement officers working for SBC, consulting and encouraging community groups to work with the council.

Having spoken with MP, Michelle has been working on the Fox Roundabout; complete costing from SBC is £23K with extensive permissions to go through. HCPG sub group will go through. Possible funding from 106 monies, also there are sources available to assist with the form filling. Northview – understands that community hub is in the pipeline and will assist in anyway. Would more consultation help, can assist us? – Not at the moment.
