6. Report from HTC representative, RA:

Football Club – updating changing rooms, HTC working with them

Neighbourhood Plan – subject to t further 6 weeks consultation. Redlands development for 75 properties to be submitted

Police – non-dweling burglaries, regular patrols and surgeries being held on the Podium.

Police Model - being changed again, split into 2. They have a duty to protect our town and that we receive correct policing. Rate of crime has discreased.

Planning permission - 4 homes in Hampton ruled against as inside Neighbourhood Plan but outside boundary

Wroughton housing development – SBC not against as QC said no hope. KS will write as member of public to Minister for Culture and Local Government, Highworth needs to be on our guard. Also talk with local MP on 5 year housing supply, fully supports this but disagrees on basic housing policy

8. Credit Union:

Meeting 30/8 with Trevor Stinton, Supervisor and Rob Green, Director of Wiltshire Savings and Loans based in Salisbury. Andrew Hill, Financial Inclusion Office, SBC.

Would like to establish a credit union in Highworth.

Villages have been amalgamated and taking over Walcot and Parks. The Clivey want to stay independent.

Keen for expansion around Swindon,

Process a lot easier than we thought. They provide all back office we provide counter service. Creditability has to be established through regular saving before loans given.

Everything done by hand although computers are being looked into.

Interest is 3% max.

We would work with Kathryn Ford of CAP.

Costs involved? SBC obliged on this policy

Do we go ahead with setting up Credit Union in Highworth **Proposed PB seconded KenS KS** will push ahead

PB – CAP now has a second debt coach trained. In 3 years, 70 families have been assisted.

Foodbank – steady trade. Some families going 10 weeks withour money because of new Universal Credits set up. 4 or 5 seen a week

Patient Group - new questionnaire out soon. According to Moray Service, Highworth is 2nd out of 25 surgeries. Fully staffed with 15 minute appointments. Use surgery for flu jabs as this brings in money
