5. Correspondence:

Police and Commissioners Community Action Fund - £40k to share in Wiltshire between projects which relate to community safety, reduction in rural crime etc. Let **IW** know re: Safe Places, Nexus?

SR email from Anne Hinton re deal on Safe Water, £8.99 instead of £60. Is there the possibility of HCA being able to buy 10 packs? **SR** to ask.

6. Report from HTC representative, RA:

Aldi - Representatives presented to HTC with 3 options. Aldi only, Aldi and Business Park, Aldi and infrastructure. 88% of community in favour for. 2 delivery lorries per day, concerns were with regard to impact on High Street and increased traffic. They have agreed that they could advertise our High Street.

Some confusion with Councillors as to who should have been notified about proposal as Industrial Units in Neighbourhood Plan but land for Aldi not. Nothing to do with HTC as Neighbourhood Plan had already been sent to SBC in October 16. Phil Smith, SBC Forward Planning received initial correspondence on 1/12/16 from Turleigh (agents) regarding a proposal.

Existing Blackworth Industrial Units are in a poor state and large.

Swindon Town Football Club – want to redevelop and build an HQ and training facility but don't have sufficient funds, they want to build 18 houses to fund this. Planning approval for 18 holiday lodges was in place when they purchased the land. This is also outside the settlement boundary.

Junior Football Club – discussion of having an astro pitch again, would HTC support this? Planning has lapsed.

Podium - Preservation Order on tree and a Facebook petition has been set up to save tree. The tree is unsafe and could continue to dig up podium and possibly building nearby. Next step to speak to SBC to remove TPO. The podium would be removed to get at roots and rebuilt with a new Acer Gold tree in a large pot to the side of the podium.

Save Libraries – SLA from SBC legal department still not received. HTC would like to make sure that their investment in Highworth Library has been well spent. Footfall results required. Electronic wiring being done in library but not sure when card entry systems being put in. August 31st was cut off date for this service.

7. Programme for 2017:

Town Centre Update – working plan needed

- Nat West building has new windows; flats completed hopefully Café opening September.
- Lloyds Bank building has been purchased by Chris Kane, flats above, considering what retail to have on ground floor. **KS** has approached regarding having ATM reinstated, he has Chris's permission to investigate. If Cash Zone, they pick up the costs. Metro Bank?
- King and Queen has new Managers and has been done up.

Tourism – Progressing. Next meeting September.
