#### 4. Report from HTC representative: AD

**Rec** – SBC and HTC cease funding as of April 2016, when hopefully Leisure Company would have taken ownership. An open day was held and interest from 16 companies. Initial proposals in by mid-September. Need to make sure it remains a community asset. SBC have done a colour coded maintenance review, money has been put aside and being held by trustees for works to be done once new company take over. The Rec is now profitable.

# 9. The Vision and Neighbourhood Plan:

**Vision** – KS and SR met with Chris Collins, SBC Statistics who will provide information mid to late September. We need to obtain crime stats from Police and Maps from Phil Smith. New deprivation figures have been delayed but are due soon. New in depth statistics available.

**Neighbourhood Plan** – The 5 areas identified to be discussed at consultation on 12/9, there is an online questionnaire available
