### 7. Report on projects in place and planned:

Memorial Garden - on back burner. PNS has spoken with 2 stone suppliers. Path would be selffunding as you purchase a memory brick, trees could be dedicated to highworth people of interest, gardening club to be involved. Presently full of shrubs which need cutting back, colour is needed, sensory or Japanese discussed.

Safe Places – IW following up with audit of shops. To contact new CCPC for funding. The Bridge is proving the best place for safety. Possible grant available from SP in Swindon to do new leaflet. Link article to remind people.

Visit Highworth – Shut during lockdown and supported with furlough payments from Government, SBC were efficient. Re-opened with a steady flow of regulars and newbies, good feedback. Workshops, town tours have started and proving popular. With Old Town museum shutting we may get some of their artefacts to showcase.

Credit Union -

Dovecote – fell apart. New design with a quote of £3k, 2<sup>nd</sup> quote being sought. HCPG may take ownership? HTC to fund or crowdfund? Need a resident's group to run SO and AD, residents to be invited to meeting. Ongoing maintenance, insurance etc, should remain local.
